Shop till you drop for Christmas

Christmas bookings being taken already

To finish you can choose from Christmas Pudding with brandy sauce and a mince pie, Chocolate Profiteroles, or Cheese and Biscuits.

Queen's Theatre trip takes you backstage

If you've ever wondered what goes on behind the curtain as a theatre prepares to put on a performance, then you have your chance to find out by attending our Evening at the Theatre event this month.

The October 10 experience at Chamber member Queen's Theatre in Hornchurch will include a backstage tour, followed by a buffet meal, and a ticket to see top musical ONCE from the front of house later that evening.

ONCE, based on the successful film written and directed by John Carney, is set in Dublin and tells the story of a street musician and a Czech woman who are drawn together by their shared love of music.
