M25 junction 28 improvement scheme development gets green light

The National Highways announced the Secretary of State has granted a Development Consent Order, allowing plans to improve the M25 junction 28 to proceed.

Brentwood Council Leader Councillor Chris Hossack, said: "This scheme being given the go-ahead is great news. Junction 28 of the M25 is a gateway into East Anglia – into Essex and as a major route it sees a heck of a lot of traffic.

"As people will have experienced, when there is gridlock on that particular roundabout at Brook Street with large HGVs, you physically can't get onto it. This improvement scheme should take about a third of that traffic off it and alleviate the congestion that Brook Street sees daily.

"It's a national infrastructure project that is valued at more than just reducing congestion. By improving journey times and air quality too, it benefits our residents' quality of life and will be a boost to economic growth in the borough."
