Work underway to improve M25 junction 28

As you will be aware a major construction project is currently taking place with the intention of improving M25 junction 28. Daniel Cawthra, of the construction company, Graham, shared the following:

"In late 2022, we started work to improve M25 junction 28. This busy junction forms a key route between the M25 and A12, as well as providing local access to Brentwood and the A1023 Brook Street. At peak times up to 7,500 vehicles per hour pass through this junction.

We're carrying out a number of improvements to improve the flow of traffic, providing a safer and more integrated network for everyone, and bring real benefits to the drivers who use this junction daily.

We've been busy within our site between the M25 and A12, and you may have noticed lots of changes above ground, with piling machines, beam lifts, culverts being installed, and the landscape being reshaped. But there's also been a lot happening below ground, with our tunnel boring machine Tina helping divert a gas main; other service pipes and cables being moved; and protection installed over a fuel line.

We understand road closures can be frustrating, so we're doing as much work as we can within our site. We'll still need to have some closures, and we currently have a lane closed on the M25 anti-clockwise entry slip to allow us to safely build the new slip road. We'll make sure we give plenty of notice when any closures are planned.

Thank you to everyone for your patience and understanding as we work to improve this busy junction."
