Market Research - What Do Other Chambers Do?

Earlier this year, we commissioned a market research project to better understand what other chambers do. We wanted to know if there were any gaps in what we offer you in comparison to what other chambers offer. We also wanted confirmation of what we are doing right. Gillian Brooks Ltd conducted this research for us and these are some of the findings:

- 1. Our membership fees are very competitive. The average annual starting fee is £234.52 while our fees start at £72.
- 2. Our membership levels are fair and comparable.
- 3. Wednesday is the most popular day for Business Breakfasts.
- 4. We offer a comparable level of networking opportunities.
- 5. Our members' directory requires updating.
- 6. Training is generally offered by members for members and there are a few opportunities that we can take hold of here.



This was a healthy exercise and we will be considering all the findings from this Market Research report and will update you on our progress. We are committed to offering affordable and effective support to businesses in Brentwood to help you start, grow and develop confidently.

Lower Thames Crossing

Balfour Beatty has been awarded a £1.2 billion contract by National Highways to deliver the proposed Lower Thames Crossing. This crossing will create a new connection under the River Thames to increase capacity and ease congestion in the South of England.

Balfour Beatty will be responsible for the design and delivery of over 10 miles of new highways, connecting the M25 at Junction 29 and the A13 with the Lower Thames Crossing tunnel at Tilbury, Essex. In addition, the company will deliver 49 structures including bridges and major viaducts. Balfour Beatty will utilise modular construction techniques to build the structures offsite in a controlled factory environment, significantly reducing carbon emissions by minimising the number of lorry movements and material deliveries to and from site.

Throughout construction, Balfour Beatty will look to spend £500 million with local businesses and supply chain partners and will set up an 'Operator Skills Hub' to provide innovative training programmes to up-skill plant operators and inspire the next generation of talent in the UK.

The project is currently in its planning phase and completion is expected between 2029 and 2030. Balfour Beatty will directly employ a workforce of c.2,000 including c.150 apprenticeship, graduate and trainee positions.

I have had many mentors, some people who I knew personally and some who I admired from a distance. I learnt a lot from mentors, but the two strongest messages were – Be prepared to swim against the tide and if you really believe something is possible, then you are much more likely to achieve it.

What advice would you give to someone just starting up in business?

Know your target market. Don't be afraid of failure – life is a learning curve.

How do you handle setbacks or frustration?

I take a step back from the situation, look for the positive and then look for an alternative route to the solution.

What are your hobbies and interests outside of work?

My primary hobby is travelling, I have an ambition to visit 100 countries (82 so far). Although I never became an airline pilot, I did get a private pilot's licence a few years ago. I also enjoy skiing, snowboarding, cycling and kayaking.

Who would you like to spend one day with and why?

I have studied many successful entrepreneurs, and the one who interested me the most was Walt Disney I would love to talk to him about the secrets of his success.

If it has to be someone who is still alive, then it would be the investment guru Warren Buffet, but it would have to be soon as he is 93!
