# Tell us briefly about your business and how long you have worked there?

Our business is Bennetts Funeral Directors and we have evidence of being undertakers since 1881, then based at Brook Street. We moved to the current site on Brentwood High Street in 1932 and I have been working there since 1988.

#### What is your role in this business?

I am the Managing Director, overseeing the day to day.

#### What changes have you seen since you started?

The funeral business changes massively in some ways yet not at all in others. We have so many options regarding music, print, colour and media yet we're still traditionally dressed in black and the conductor with the hat and cane will walk in front of the hearse as respectfully as we always have done. The current advertising for direct cremations is changing the industry and gives families little chance to grieve.

#### What was your first job?

After I left college in Chelmsford I moved to Suffolk and worked at the Government offices, DoE, in Cambridge.

# What job did you think you would like to do when you were a child?

More than likely something to do with animals.

#### Who do you admire in the business world?

Yvon Chouinard who founded the outdoor brand Patagonia and 1% for the Planet.

# Have you had any mentors and if so, what did you learn from them?

Various business advisors from Business Link as it was and other family funeral directors.

## What advice would you give to someone just starting up in business?

To ensure you have sufficient funds for back up and to look to provide the best customer service.

#### How do you handle setbacks or frustrations?

In business you take chances, if they go wrong, you learn from them. Keep learning.

What are your hobbies and interests outside of work? Family, dogs, travel and gardening.

#### Who would you like to spend one day with and why?

Sir David Attenborough – who wouldn't! He has given such awareness to how we're failing our planet, it needs saving.

## **Brentwood Council : Devolution**

Following the government's announcement that Essex County Council and Thurrock and Southend are part of the Devolution Priority Programme, a consultation on devolution proposals for Essex has begun.

The election of a Mayor and a Combined Authority will impact businesses in securing funding for local projects, making strategic decisions, and helping attract investment and improving infrastructure. The Council will argue for the best possible outcome for Brentwood's residents.

The government has requested public input into their plans for devolution, including devolving certain powers and responsibilities to a Mayor. The consultation results will inform any decision on the duties of a Mayor of Essex. A strong public response to the consultation will be a significant factor in any government decision, including how business will be treated.
