Tell us briefly about your business and how long you have worked there?

Pinney Talfourd is a full service law firm located in Upminster, Hornchurch, Brentwood and Chelmsford. We now have around 120 employees (but increasing by the day), 77 lawyers and 16 partners. We have an extensive private client team dealing with

wills, probate, estates and trusts and a tier 1 legal 500 family department with one of the largest teams in Essex. We cover all areas of law (including conveyancing and general litigation) save for immigration and criminal work.

What is your role in this business?

I am a partner who heads up the commercial team dealing with commercial property and company and commercial transactions.

How long have you worked there?

I joined Pinney Talfourd in 2011 and became a partner in 2014. I will have been at Pinney Talfourd for 15 years this year.

What was your first job?

My first job was working in a dairy in Sible Hedingham working on the factory floor dealing with the packaging of milk and dairy products.

What job did you think you would like to do when you were a child?

Sadly, I wanted to be a solicitor from quite a young age. I believe I started out wanting to be judge but thought the wig would be itchy.

Who do you admire in the business world?

I think I would have to say Bill Gates who made Microsoft a tool we all use every day, however, I have admiration for anyone who has the vision to see a niche or gap in the market and the drive to fill it.

Have you had any mentors and if so, what did you learn from them?

I have benefited from guidance and advice from a number of great solicitors over the years in a number of firms. It may be clichéd but I also need to recognise my parents for instilling a work drive which has got me where I am.

What advice would you give to someone just starting up in business?

Take a deep breath and work the problem. Break it down, prioritise and do one job at a time and do it well.
